



DATA PROTECTION POLICY FOR NATURAL PERSONS

ART. 1 - GENERAL INFORMATION

This policy applies to personal data that we collect about you when you browse our website, utopix.com.

By using our website, utopix.com, or by providing us with your data, whatever channel you use, you agree to the following terms. If you do not agree to these terms, we urge you not to use our website or share your data with us.

You are free not to share your data with us. In such cases, however, you agree not to benefit from the full visibility and other advantages offered by our company, notably through our website, utopix.com.

ART.2 - DATA CONTROLLER DETAILS

Utopix Pictures SA, a public limited company in Belgian law, with registered office at Rue Emile Francqui 6, 1435 Mont-Saint-Guibert, Belgium, listed on the Central Enterprise Databank under number BE 0679.670.783 in the register of legal persons within the jurisdiction of the District Court of Brabant Wallon, is responsible for the processing of personal data (hereinafter referred to as "data") which you provide directly to us on our website, utopix.com.

ART. 3 - DATA THAT WE COLLECT

3.1 Data that we collect directly from you

Data may include the personal data that you provide us, including your surname, first name, home address, landline telephone number, mobile telephone number and e-mail address.

3.2 Data that we collect when you use the website

Our website uses "cookies". By visiting the website, you agree to receive cookies on your computer, tablet or smartphone. Cookies enable us to optimise your browsing experience on our website (for example, they help us remember your preferences during your visit).

We encourage you to consult our Cookie Policy on our website for more information on this technology and your associated rights.

ART. 4 - PURPOSES FOR USING YOUR DATA

Utopix Pictures uses your data (including photos) for the purpose of marketing to existing or potential customers. Utopix Pictures processes your data to the extent necessary for the purposes for which it was obtained.

ART. 5 - LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

The legal basis for data processing is set out in EU data protection regulations, either in your consent to the processing of your data for the purposes set out in point 4 and/or in the necessity of such processing for the performance of a contract to which you are a party or for the performance of pre-contractual measures taken at your request.

ART.6 - TRANSMISSION TO THIRD PARTIES

We do not sell or disclose in any way the data we collect about you to third parties.

In the delivery of our services, we may be required to subcontract, in whole or in part, some of our tasks to subcontractors who are bound by a contract with us.

Utopix Pictures requires its subcontractors to comply with data protection regulations and that subcontractors provide sufficient guarantees regarding the implementation of appropriate technical and organizational measures, so that the processing meets the requirements of data protection legislation and guarantees the protection of your rights.

ART.7 - YOUR RIGHTS

7.1 Right of Access

You have the right to consult your data at any time and free of charge, by sending an email to hello@utopix.com or by writing to our head office.

7.2 Right of Correction

You have the right to require that incorrect data be corrected and that inappropriate or unnecessary data be deleted by sending an e-mail to hello@utopix.com or by submitting a written request to our head office.

Please note that you are required to verify the accuracy of data that you provide us at all times.

7.3 Right to be forgotten

When you no longer want your data to be processed and deem it appropriate to invoke the right of erasure, we will then remove your data from the Utopix Pictures databases.

Deletion will take place within one month of notification of your application, unless the data must be kept in order to comply with a legal obligation or for recording or identification purposes, or the exercise of a legal defence in court.

7.4 Right to Portability

If necessary, you will also be entitled to the portability of your data in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

7.5 Right of Opposition

You have the right to object to any use of your data for prospecting purposes. You may exercise your right of opposition either through automated processes, or alternatively by sending an e-mail to hello@utopix.com.

7.6 Right of Restriction of processing

You also have the right to obtain from Utopix Pictures the restriction of the processing of your data, in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

ART.8 - DURATION OF DATA STORAGE

We will keep your data when performing the pre-contractual measures, and, if necessary, for the entire period during which you are a member of Utopix Pictures, plus a period of 5 (five) years from the date of the notification, which you will give us, of your decision to end your membership.

ART. 9 - SECURITY

We have developed appropriate technical and organisational security rules to avoid destruction, loss, falsification, modification, unauthorized access, accidental communication to third parties and any other unauthorized processing of the Data.

ART. 10 - RESPONSIBILITY

Utopix Pictures' liability will be limited to direct damage, excluding any indirect damage. Utopix Pictures shall in no way be held liable for any damages deemed indirect, including, but not limited to, loss of Data, financial or commercial loss, loss of profits, increase in overheads, disruption to planning.

Utopix Pictures accepts no responsibility for any damage caused by unlawful manipulation by third parties of the data (e.g. data theft, viruses, phishing or other computer offences).

Should Utopix Pictures be held liable, liability shall be limited to the value of your annual contribution.
